Entries must be received by 6 pm CDT Thursday October 12, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient funds will render the entry invalid; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of the test. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. Entries received without signature release will be returned.

Entry Limits/Preference: Entry is limited to AKC registered dogs 6 months of age or older.

TDU test: Entries for dogs without a TD or TDU title must have included with the entry form a notice of certification from an AKC tracking judge (dated within one year of the test) stating the dog is ready for such a test.

VST test: Dogs must have a TD or TDU title to enter the VST test. Dogs with the VST title may enter but will have lower priority in the entry draw (see below).

The TDU test is limited to 2 TDU tracks. The VST test is limited to 4 VST tracks.

Preference in the drawing will be given as follows:

TDU test VST test

1) Belgian Tervuren without a TD or TDU title

2) Belgian Tervuren with a TD or TDU title

3) All other breeds without a TD or TDU title

4) All other breeds with a TD or TDU title

The draw will be conducted at the Test Secretary's address at 7pm CDT on October 12. All entrants will be contacted via email (phone if no email is listed on the entry form) as soon as possible after

Upon notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing placement on the alternate list. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, the first alternate entry present according to the order in which they were drawn shall fill the vacant position.

In the event an accepted entry cancels after closing of entries, the Test Secretary shall contact alternates in the order of their placement on the alternate list. Upon such notification, alternates shall have the option to accept or decline the opportunity to participate in the test.

Entry Acknowledgements: Entry forms with email addresses will be sent entry receipts via email. GLBTC is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Entries without email addresses will receive only final confirmations after closing. If receipt of entry notification is desired, a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope must be included with the entry form. All entrants/alternates will be emailed a judging program after the draw.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disgualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Test Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Test Committee make it impossible to open or complete the test.

Refunds will be made for any alternate who is does not participate in the draw for tracks, and for any absent/withdrawn entrant whose track is filled by an alternate.

TEST INFORMATION:

All dogs must be on leash at all times during the hours of this test. PLEASE clean up after yourselves and your dogs!

The draw for track order for both TDU and VST will occur at 8:30 am at the test site. The first TDU track will run as soon as possible thereafter. VST tracks will run after the TDU test has been completed.

Bitches in season may participate provided that the Test Secretary and Judges are notified that a bitch in season is present <u>prior to the drawing for tracks</u>. The last track shall be reserved for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held.

HOSPITALITY: There will be breakfast, beverages and snacks available at the test site.

AWARDS: Each dog who earns a Pass in these tracking tests will receive a dark green rosette and a goodie bag of dog-related items.

The UW-Whitewater & Club's Protocols are as follows: The test site is on University property and the club has special permission to be at this site. No training at this site is permitted without prior written approval of the Board of GLBTC. Violators will be subject to an Event committee hearing for endangering the Club's ability to hold events at this site. Please respect this area by cleaning up after your dog. No dogs are to be allowed to be off lead – dogs shall be on lead at all times on any area of the tracking site.

Cancellation of Event may occur due to extreme hazardous weather conditions as determined by the Tracking Committee and Judges.

From Chicago: (approximate travel time a little over 2hr) take I-90 West to Exit 171A. Then take Hwy 26N to Milton. At stoplight, turn right onto Hwy 59 East to Whitewater. Turn left on Main St, then right on Fremont St and then left onto E. Schwager Drive and park by the Lawcon picnic area on the left.

From Madison: (approximate travel time 1 hr) take I-90 East to Exit 163 (Milton/Edgerton exit). Take Hwy 59 east, then left onto County "N" to Whitewater. After you cross Hwy 89S/12E turn left at Indian Mound Parkway, then right on Main St/Hwy12. Go past stoplight in front of McDonald's and turn left onto Prairie St. to E. Schwager Drive. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering. i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- 5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/ Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
