Entry Payment:

By **check or money order** (made out to CAPER) or by **Zelle** (to secretary@caper-dogs.com). These methods have no extra fee. One check or Zelle payment is sufficient for all your dogs' entries.

By **PayPal or credit card** at caper-dogs.com, PayPal/Credit Card link. **Payment must include \$2 per class additional charge for the entries to be valid.**

Entries must be received by 6:00 pm CST Wednesday, February 19 after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are printed without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will render the entry invalid; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature.

Entries received without signature release will be returned.

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed after closing.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Entry fees for bitches entered in agility, obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date will be refunded in full, and fees for injured dogs will be refunded less \$6/class, if notice is given to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the judging of that sport's classes. Injured dog refund requests will require a veterinarian certificate.

Entry Errors: Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Duplicate entries will not be refunded after closing. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

Transfers to higher levels: Transfers are available to dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements to advance to a higher level after the closing date, in any offered sport. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show/Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for which the transfer is requested.

Site Information

All events will be held at CarDunAI Dog Training Club, 10783 Wolf Dr, Huntley IL. The facility is 15,000 sq ft and has a 3/4" cushioned mat surface. The agility ring size is 70' x 125'. Protective matting is required under wire crates & chairs to protect the surface.

There will be no barking dogs allowed in vehicles, they must be crated inside.

No dogs are allowed in the building overnight. Overnight parking is not allowed.

More detailed information regarding the parking areas will be provided in the judging program.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEMSELVES & THEIR DOGS!
NO SMOKING IN THE BUILDING. NO FIREARMS ALLOWED ON THE SITE.

There are currently no mask mandates. If the local, state or federal regulations change and masks are required, you will be notified as much in advance as possible. Masks may be required in the rings at the judges' discretion.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE

From the east, take I-90 to the Route 47 exit. Go north on Route 47 ~3.7 miles to Oakcrest Dr and turn left (known as Algonquin Rd to the right). Take the first left onto Wolf Dr and then immediately turn right into the business park. Go straight to the end of the drive and turn left. CDA is in the last section of the building on the left.

From the west, take I-90 to the Route 20 exit. Go west (left) 1.6 miles to Harmony Rd and turn right Drive 3.7 miles to the stop sign, then turn left to stay on Harmony Rd. Drive to the next stop sign and turn right onto Main St. Drive 1.4 miles on Main St to Route 47 and turn left. Go .4 miles north on Route 47 to Oakcrest Dr (known as Algonquin Road to the right) and turn left. Take the first left onto Wolf Dr and then immediately turn right into the business park. Go straight to the end of the drive and turn left. CDA is in the last section of the building on the left.

In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The club and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

RINGSIDE: Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog. Owners and agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs at ringside when their class is called. The club, judges, stewards and secretary have no obligation or responsibility to announce for or locate dogs that are not at ringside when required.

AGILITY

Trial Information

- Trial is limited to Belgian Tervuren. Unlimited entry number.
- Entrants must be at least 15 months old and be registered with AKC (ILP/PAL acceptable). Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate.
- By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All measurements at the dog's withers.

Regular classes

20 inches For dogs over 18" & to 22"

24 inches For dogs over 22"

Dogs MAY enter a higher jump height.

Preferred Classes

16 inches For dogs over 18" & to 22"

20 inches For dogs over 22"

Dogs MAY NOT enter a higher jump height.

- CLASSES OFFERED (in running order): FAST (all levels by height), Standard, T2B, JWW Standard & JWW will run Master/Excellent - Open - Novice. All classes small to tall. Judging start time will be determined once entries close, but it will not be before 8am.
- FEO & FIX AND GO: any run can be announced prior to the run as FEO; any run can be signaled as Fix & Go by the handler. See Ch 4, Sec 7 & 8 of the AKC Agility Regulations for full rule details.
- HEIGHT CARDS: All entered dogs must have a valid jump height card or they will need to be measured prior to running at the trial. There will be a VMO present for height card measurements
- REFUNDS: Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. See page 3 in this premium list for refund information for bitches in season and injured dogs.
- MOVEUPS: Moveups to a higher level may be made after closing. The moveup deadline is Monday, March 3 at 6pm CST.

Working Sweepstakes is open to all AKC registered Belgian Tervuren who fulfill the title requirements of the classes as listed. Entrants do not need to be entered in a regular class, and may be altered. Champions of Record may compete. Classes divided by sex.

Each class requires titles in at least two areas of AKC competition (obedience, rally, agility, herding, tracking, scent work), one of which is at a level higher than the entry level title.

ALL ENTRANTS: Please enter your dog's jump height (if applicable) on the entry form.

Transfers to the next higher level in both obedience and rally are allowed per AKC rules and regulations. Bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after closing will receive a full entry fee refund if written notice is given to the secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for that day.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for Belgian Tervuren that are 4 months of age but under 6 months on the day of the event. An AKC registration number or litter number will be required for each entry. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs/has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last 5 years.
- All entries must be received by the closing date. No entries will be taken at ringside.

The Certificate of Merit (CM) title is an introductory title to AKC conformation events. Entrants shall compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex. The Best of Breed winner will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the total number of dogs competing. The Best of Opposite Sex winner will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their sex.

The Certificate of Merit requires 15 points awarded in accordance with the following points structure.

Dogs Competing – Points: 2 dogs: 1 pt • 4 dogs: 2 pts • 8 dogs: 3 pts • 12 dogs: 4 pts • 16 dogs: 5 pts

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Open class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Master class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.
